
General U-Bill Information

- First U-Bill of each semester
 - Fall August 1st
 - Spring January 1st
- Email notification sent 1st of each month
 - to student's U of Iowa email address
 - does <u>not</u> contain a copy of the U-Bill
- Guest Account: used to view U-Bill
 - Access authorized by student
 - Like University of Iowa Billing on Facebook
- Due Date: 22nd of each month



Billing & Payment Agreement

- Outlines terms of student financial responsibility
- Policies for billing, charge disputes, payments & collection
- Agreement to receive electronic delivery of billing documents
- Authorization to apply financial aid to outstanding charges on bill
- Electronically signed each semester, prior to registration

Deferred Payment Plan

- Eligible Charges
 - Tuition
 - Housing Room & Meal Plan
- 3 installments payments

Semester	Payment 1	Payment 2	Payment 3
Fall	August	September	October
Spring	January	February	March

- No formal enrollment process
 - required to pay minimum due each month
- \$20 per-semester Deferred Payment Fee



Miscellaneous Charges

All other charges are due in the month billed

- Charges made with ID Card
 - University Book Store
 - Food Service & Vending
 - Campus convenience stores
 - Recreational Services
 - Athletic and performing arts tickets
- Course fees
- Library fines










Miscellaneous Charges

- Parking Tickets
 - Billed to registered owner of vehicle
 - If student registers vehicle with U of I Parking
 - Tickets placed on student's U-Bill
 - Reduced rate tickets for students
- Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP)
 - All students required to have health insurance
 - Monthly insurance premium charged to U-Bill if not covered by an alternate insurance plan

- Online through MyUI
 - checking or savings account
- In Person (2700 University Capitol Centre)
 - Personal check, cashier's check, money order
- Mail to Payment Processing Center
 - Include payment stub in envelope
- Credit Card
 - 2.75% non-refundable service fee for domestic credit cards
- •529 Plans
 - Speak with your 529 plan administrator



Late or Returned U-Bill Payments

- Minimum payment is \$100+ & not paid by due date
 - 1. Charging Restriction
 - 2. Registration Restriction
 - 3. \$25 late fee per month
- \$30 fee for all returned checks & online payments

Disbursement of Financial Aid Refunds

- Aid Refunds
 - Begin the first week of classes
 - Quickest refund → direct deposit set up on MyUI
- Parent PLUS Loans
 - Excess funds sent to the borrower (student, if specified)
 - Borrower Direct Deposit setup
 - Through MyUI Guest Account OR
 - Parent PLUS Loan Direct Deposit Authorization Form



1098-T Tax Form

 Form to take advantage of educational-related tax deductions

- Report to the IRS
 - Tuition & qualifying fees paid in the calendar year
 - Gift Aid (scholarships and grants)
- Available on MyUI by January 31st each year

- Set a reminder on your calendar to review the U-Bill after the 1st of each month

The Federal Direct Parent PLUS loan or private loans are additional credit-based loans.


UI Deferred Payment Plan

You can choose to pay your U-Bill in full, or for a \$20 fee, take advantage of the interest-free deferred payment plan and pay in three monthly installments each semester.



Types of Financial Aid

- Scholarships
- Grants
- Work-Study
- Loans





- Scholarships and Grants
 - Free money
 - View renewal requirements on MyUI
 - Scholarship Renewal Requirements
 - File FAFSA by December 1 each year
 - Report additional scholarships in MyUI under Financial Aid Offer
 - Iowa Scholarship Portal opens September 1 for 2021-22



- Work-Study
 - Use Handshake to find a job
 - Work-study is not required to work on campus
 - 7,000 students work on campus, 1,000 have work-study
 - Paid to student every two weeks for the hours worked
 - Employer pays 50%, work-study pays 50%
 - Does not go towards the U-Bill



- Student Loan Options (student is the borrower)
- Subsidized and Unsubsidized
 - Subsidized interest free in school 2.75% during repayment
 - Unsubsidized interest right away 2.75%
 - Master Promissory Note
 - Entrance Counseling
 - Loan Acceptance
- \$5,500 maximum for first year students



- Parent Loan Option (parent is the borrower)
 - Parent PLUS loan
 - Master Promissory Note
 - PLUS Request each semester
 - Includes credit check (good for 180 days)
 - Option to defer payments while in school
 - 5.3% interest rate
 - 4% origination fee



- Private Loan Option
 - Parent borrower OR
 - Student borrower with co-signer
 - Private loan counseling required (can be done over phone)
 - Preferred lender list available on our website



- When should I have my financial aid in place?
 - By the beginning of July for financial aid to show up on the August 1 U-Bill



2021-2022 FAFSA

- Opens October 1, 2020.
- 2019 income information
 - Contact us if changes have occurred
- Use IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the FAFSA
